Hon. James Gachomba: Thank you Mr. Speaker. I beg to move the following motion: That this House does adopt the Report on the Nyandarua County 2nd Supplementary Appropriations Bill, 2016 as a report of this House and the recommendations therein as resolutions of this House.

Mr. Speaker, Sir, the Committee was mandated to go to Naivasha to come up with a report on the Nyandarua County 2nd Supplementary Appropriations Bill, 2016.

Considering that fellow Members have copies of the report in their files, I wish to go directly to the introduction of the report.

INTRODUCTION

Preparation and submission of the County 2nd Supplementary Budget Estimates for the financial year 2015/2016

Pursuant to Section 135 (1) and (2) of the Public Finance Management Act 2012 the County 2nd Supplementary Budget Estimates FY2015/2016 was prepared and submitted to the County Assembly.

Notably, the County government has two arms; the County Executive and the County Assembly. In this context, the County Executive arm did not supplement its budget estimates and therefore guided by the fiscal responsibility principles, on the 12th day of May 2016 the County Assembly Clerk being the Accounting Officer prepared and submitted the 2nd Supplementary Budget Estimates for the financial year 2015/2016 to the County Assembly and the same was duly laid before the House on Wednesday the 18th March, 2016 in a special sitting for further scrutiny, consideration and approval.

Scrutiny of the County 2nd Supplementary Budget for the financial year 2015/2016 for the County Assembly.

Pursuant to the provision of the County Assembly Standing Orders Article 210 the supplementary budget estimates upon being laid before the Assembly the estimates were committed to the Budget

and Appropriations Committee to deliberate upon according to its respective mandate and make recommendations to the House for adoption.

Submission and examination of the County 2nd Supplementary Appropriations Bill, 2016

In accordance with Section 129 (7) of the Public Finance Management Act, 2012 the County Treasury prepared the County 2nd Supplementary Appropriation Bill 2016.

Upon receipt of the County Supplementary Appropriation Bill 2016 the same was tabled in the House on Tuesday the 7th June, 2016 and through a resolution of the House it was committed to the Budget and Appropriations Committee for scrutiny and compilation of a report.

The Committee scrutinized the County 2nd Supplementary Appropriation Bill 2016 and has made the following observations and recommendations.

(Hon. Michael Kirumba rises on a point of order)

Speaker: What is it Member for Kipipiri, Hon. Michael Kirumba?

Hon. Michael Kirumba: Mr. Speaker, whatever the mover of motion is going through has not found its way into our files.

Speaker: You mean copies of the report are not in the Members files?

Hon. Michael Kirumba: Yes, they are not in our files. The copies have just been supplied and some of us have not gotten the copies. Copies of reports whose motion are being moved should be getting into our files early.

Speaker: Very well; the mover can withhold going through the report until copies of the same are put in all the Members files. Actually it is the responsibility of the Members to ascertain that what movers of motions on reports present is what is contained in the reports. We had even agreed that copies of a report whose motion is being moved should be put in Members files three days before the motion is moved to give Members time to scrutinise the same.

I believe that in a few minutes' time copies of the report whose motion is being moved will be in the Members files.

(Hon. Samuel Thuita rises on a point of order)

What it Member for Gathanji, Hon. Samuel Thuita?

Hon. Samuel Thuita: Mr. Speaker, the report was supposed to be tabled yesterday; but the Committee chairperson said that it would be ready by morning today. Actually the Committee worked for it overnight and the delay should be understood.

Speaker: We appreciate that the Committee worked overnight, but I have said that when a motion on a report is being moved Members should have copies of the report in their files.

(The Speaker consults with the clerk-at-the-table)

The members who do not have copies of the report might not get them immediately because they are being produced. Only ten full copies of the report were made. So I suggest that Members who do not have copies of the report share the available copies as the mover proceeds to go through the report. But the clerk assistant concerned should ensure that Members who do not have a copy of the report get the same within the shortest time possible.

Speaker: What is it Member for Rurii?

Hon. Wahome Kamoche: Mr. Speaker, are we reading from the same script? The mover has read the figure approved by this Assembly for County Attorney, ICT, e-government and Intergovernmental Relations as Kshs. 53,231,782, yet my copy reads Kshs. 36,050,000.

Chairperson of the Committee on Budget and Appropriations should clarify on the issues of the two figures that have been raised for purposes of record.

Hon. Members, the copy of the report that the Member for Rurii has is the same as the copy every other member has. It is only that Hon. Wahome Kamoche was reading figure for the recurrent expenditure while the chair was reading the figure for the development (capital) expenditure on the same department.

39. THAT, the County Treasury may issue out of the County Revenue Fund and apply towards the supply granted for the services of the year ending 30th June, 2016, the sum of Kenya shillings 12,500,000 for County Trade Development Fund

In conclusion, pursuant to Section 129 (7) of the Public Finance Management Act and the County Assembly Standing Orders the Committee acknowledges the preparation and submission of the County 2nd Supplementary Appropriation Bill 2016 and therefore; I urge that the aforementioned recommendations be resolutions of the House and that the Nyandarua County 2nd Supplementary Appropriation Bill 2016 is now read a second time. Thank you Mr. Speaker.

Speaker: Yes, Member for Gathanji, Hon. Samuel Thuita

Hon. Samuel Thuita: Thank you Mr. Speaker. I rise to support the report by the Committee on Budget and Appropriations. As the chairperson has read, it is very clear that appropriation bill on the supplementary budget intends to ensure that money is available in the next 20 days within which the implementers should ensure that they have expended the money.

Mr. Speaker, in this report, the committee noted that there is over Ksh. 500 million meant for development in the county revenue fund which has not been expended as at now. When we are therefore passing the appropriation bill on the supplementary budget we should have it in our minds that it is the image of the entire county that gets dented when money goes back to the treasury. Besides, we are aware that the Executive blames the Assembly for being a hindrance if the money goes back to the treasury.

I say this because when H.E. the Governor was in J.M. Memorial Hospital, he openly blamed the Assembly for not doing enough in support of his development agenda. In other words, his point was that it is this House that has been derailing the Executive.

It is therefore our wish that within the next 20 days, we shall spend the more than half a billion shillings laying in the county revenue fund. As such, I second this motion and the report as presented by the chair, Committee on Budget and Appropriations. Thank you.
