Speaker: Very well, we can now proceed with the business for this sitting. First Order.

1. RECURRENT AND DEVELOPMENT EXPENDITURE RETURNS

Speaker: Yes Hon. Peter Kamau Gathungu, Leader of the Majority Party.

Hon. Gathungu Kamau: Thank you Mr Speaker. I rise to table the Recurrent and Development Expenditure Returns for the period ending 31st December 2017. Thank you Mr Speaker.

Speaker: Thank you Leader of the Majority Party. The Chairperson of the Committee on Budget and Appropriations, when will your Committee be ready to present a report on the same.

2. NYANDARUA COUNTY TRADE FUND REGULATIONS, 2016

Speaker: Yes Hon. Wairimu Njane, Chairperson, Trade, Co-operatives, Industrialisation and Enterprise Development Committee.

Hon. Wairimu Njane: Thank you Mr Speaker. Pursuant to Standing Order 191(2), I beg to table The Nyandarua County Trade Fund Regulations, 2016 for consideration by this House.
