**Speaker:** Yes member for Rurii and chairperson committee on delegated county legislations, Hon. Wahome Kamoche.

**Hon. Wahome Kamoche:** Thank you Mr Speaker, I beg to table the report of the committee on delegated county legislations on the “Recommendations of Nyandarua County Assembly leadership and integrity code.”

This is a very crucial document that touches on every member of this House and the lifeline of this House. It is therefore, my humble request to have the committee of the whole house to be taken through this document so that they have a thorough understanding before they append their signatures, which will be done before the principal magistrate. Additionally, we had requested that we be taken through this document by the delegated legislations committees of the senate and the national assembly.

**Speaker:** Member for Rurii, I understand that once you table the document here, it becomes the property of this House and the members, therefore, are at liberty to get acquainted with it. They do not need to have it read to them in the committee of the whole House. Secondly, this document is bound by EACC timelines and we may not have the time to go to Senate or have them come here.

**Speaker:** Yes member for Ndaragwa Central.

**Hon. Peter Mwangi Maina:** Mr Speaker, my understanding is that Hon. Kamoche wants us to understand this document before we append our signatures and I am in full support of that.

**Speaker:** Yes member for Gatimu, Hon Kieru Wambui.

**Hon. Kieru Wambui:** Thank you Mr Speaker. I would wish to comment on the matter at hand. The chairperson raises pertinent issues and requests, through you, to have the members of the House taken through the document before it is moved.

Maybe his committee has the resources to facilitate this kind of training or if it doesn't have, the assembly's leadership is here and it could facilitate this request through the office of the Speaker and the Clerk. This is an issue of training. We cannot be trained after we have adopted the document. This again, is a personal choice. We cannot be forced to append our signatures on a document we do not understand. I support Hon. Kamoche's request.

**Speaker:** Yes member for Kaimbaga, Hon. Njiraini.

**Hon. Kimani Njiraini:** Thank you Mr Speaker, as a member of the committee on delegated county legislations, I fully understand the seriousness of this document. I know it has dire implications and could follow us to our graves. I have perused the document and I feel that the rest of the members should be taken through it before a motion is moved in this House.

**Speaker:** Yes member for Njabini Kiburu, Hon. Gachomba.

**Hon. James Gachomba:** Thank you Mr Speaker, I would like to comment on this too and support the chairperson of the Committee on Delegated County Legislations of which I am a member. The committee has recommended a fact finding visit to the National Assembly so that the members can appreciate the content of this code of conduct. No one has any objection to being a person of integrity, as stated in the code of conduct, but there are some parts that need to be amended by the House before we adopt it.

**Speaker:** Thank you members, but remember that this code of conduct was brought to this House and was approved. It was then taken to EACC for approval and recommendations before it was brought back to the House. This document is bound by a timeline and it has already become a property of the House. Now then, we shall sit with the House Business Committee and allocate time for this House to be taken through the document by the relevant agencies.
