**Speaker:** What is it member for Gathanji, Hon. Ngumo Ngamau?

**Hon. Ngumo Ngamau:** Thank you Mr Speaker. I do not know whether it is on order but I want to say that the process that the chairperson has taken us through the process of passing the finance bill and it was fascinating. I can say that the Committee on Finance is a great committee. However, Mr Speaker I would like to say this, I have gone to other counties and I have seen how they collect taxes. In Nyandarua we take taxes from shoe shiners, small shops. This morning I noted that we are supposed to collect about Kshs. 370 million. The work done is a lot but the money received is very little. I think we should borrow from other counties. In Nyeri County we have two cash crops tea and coffee. The officers go to the factories and collect data of the daily coffee or tea collection. They make calculations of about 2 cents per kg of coffee or tea. That is why they are able to repair roads annually.

In Nyandarua, we have milk collection centres such as Brookside, Nyala, Ol'kalou dairy and others. In Nyandarua, we collect about seven million litres of milk per day, we multiply that by thirty days, and by three-sixty days, those are so many litres of milk. If would have people collecting data from there, then the county charges as little as fifty cents per litre of milk, we can get Kshs. 370 million shillings. This will be easy to collect because we shall not need vehicles and enforcement officers to go there to get it. KCC and Brookside buy milk at about 30 shillings per litre.

Initially Mr Speaker we had toll stations where vehicle would pass through and pay taxes. The government realized that there was misappropriation and could not account for it. They went to the petrol stations and they charge a little amount per every litre of fuel.

I know this is not very timely but you can advise us on this.

**Speaker:** I think that is an idea that the executive has not thought about and it is very progressive looking at the milk we sell and the water we give away and even the pyrethrum and potato factories that we look forward to have. If we charge those cents as it is done in Murang'a, Kiambu and Kirinyaga counties, I think one item only would raise about Kshs. 70 million that we are struggling to raise. This is important and because it is a fundamental issue, it was not subjected to public participation. It came as a policy from the executive.

As an assembly, what we can do is in consultation with the Finance Committee, draft a very comprehensive motion on that issue; we debate it, make resolutions and hand them to the

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executive to consider these streams of taxation in the next year's finance bill. Otherwise, I think that would solve many problems in terms of increasing revenue in this county. Next
