Assembly Debates

The House Met at 2.30 PM

Hon Speaker in the Chair

**Hon Mwangi Gichuki:** I want to take this opportunity to bring to the attention of the House and the Honourable Speaker that the House Business Committee did adopt the Senate Calendar in relation to the business of the Assembly and even after adopting the Senate Calendar, the Senate opted to go on recess on the 5<sup>th</sup> of December. Mr. Speaker due to the quagmire that has been there between the assemblies in Kenya and Salaries and Remuneration Commission, there was need to reopen the assemblies and to close an official matter and this necessitated this Assembly Mr. Speaker to reassemble on the 10<sup>th</sup> of December.

Mr. Speaker bearing in mind that we had adopted the Senate's Calendar it therefore dictates Mr. Speaker that this Assembly actually adjoin other assemblies, which have actually adopted the Senate's calendar, which requires that we go on recess. In relation to the calendar is sixty-seven days and therefore Mr. Speaker guided by **Standing Order No 28** I would wish to move a motion of adjournment up to 11 February, which will be a Tuesday, Year 2014 to be able to comply with our adopted assemblies' calendar. Mr. Speaker, I beg to move.

**Hon Kariuki Muchiri.** Mr. Speaker Sir, I rise to second the motion by the Leader of Majority that this House goes on recess until February next year.

Mr. Speaker this is in accordance with the calendar of the Senate, which we have actually adopted. Therefore, Mr. Speaker I do second.

**Speaker:** Therefore Honourable members I am not required to put a question on this one because we are complying with our own Calendar and the motion has

been duly seconded and therefore the House after this communication will stand adjourned.

I wish to report that Honourable members you will be reporting for your training on Sunday and you will be checking out on 19<sup>th</sup>, Sunday will be 15<sup>th</sup>. Further communication and facilitation will be communicated to you by the office of the Clerk.

Again, Honourable Members we were to have a Kamukunji and I can see most of the members have left and again Honourable Members I have an emergency to attend to immediately. That is why you found I have not responded to the member for Kipipiri because I have to go right away. So I do not know when we will have this matter because we have so many matters pending which cannot wait until 11<sup>th</sup> February. I would be putting it to the Leader of Majority to work on it between the 20<sup>th</sup> and 23<sup>rd</sup>.

I am told we can have a kamukunji on the 20<sup>th</sup> and start early so that we can deal with it because we will be having interviews that will be going on at the ACK hall. So you can note that you be reporting for training on 15<sup>th</sup> and the Kamukunji on 20<sup>th</sup>. The Venue will be the Kenya Institute of Monetary Studies. The arrangements are the same, the way you are facilitated and the training starts on 16<sup>th</sup>.

Therefore, Honourable Members I now declare that this House is adjourned until Tuesday 11<sup>th</sup> of February 2014 at 2.30 PM.
