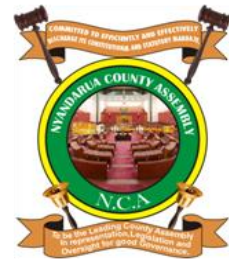

  - i. **Hon. Patriciah Wanjugu Njoroge (County Member, Karau Ward)**

Mr. Speaker Sir, I beg to give notice of the following motion:

**Aware** that the National Government has in each financial year set aside funds for the purchase and distribution of subsidized fertilizers to farmers and the County Government has been distributing the said fertilizer to the farmers from designated places across the County;

**Noting** that the fertilizer has been of pivotal assistance to the farmers by reducing the cost of farming and many farmers in Nyandarua County have been seeking access to the subsidized fertilizer;

**Concerned** that the fertilizer distributed in the 2014/2015 Financial Year had negative effects and impact on crop growth and production and thus leading to reduced general output from farmers and economic loss to a majority of farmers ;

**Further** concerned of the need to ensure that the fertilizer distributed to farmers meets the prescribed standards and does not negatively affect the growth and productivity of crops;

I now therefore urge this Assembly does resolve that the County Executive Committee Member for Agriculture, Livestock and Fisheries does urgently take samples of the fertilizer to the Government Chemist for analysis and look into ways of mitigating the problem including, if established that the fertilizer is inappropriate ,stopping any further distribution and sale of the fertilizer.

ii. **Hon. James Kiiru Gachomba (Member for Njabini/Kiburu Ward)**

Mr. Speaker Sir, I beg to give notice of the following motion:

**Aware** that the Constitution 2010, under Article 69(1) (b) requires the State to ensure that there is sustainable exploitation, utilization and management of the environment and natural resources and to ensure that there is equitable sharing of the accruing benefits;

**Noting** that Nyandarua County is endowed with water catchment areas and natural water which is a natural resource consumed in neighboring counties including Nairobi, Nakuru and Laikipia;

**Further** noting that there is constructed in Nyandarua County within the Kinangop Sub-County, the Sasumwa Dam for collecting and preserving water for consumption in Nairobi County and is managed by Nairobi Water and Sewerage Company.

**Concerned** that the water collected in the Dam and the monetary benefit accruing from the commercial sale thereof , is not shared with the people of Nyandarua County against the national principles on natural resources;

I now therefore I urge the Assembly to resolve that the County Department on Intergovernmental Relations, does institute appropriate steps towards ensuring that the people of Nyandarua County benefit from the water and monetary benefits accruing from the sale of water collected at Sasumwa Dam.
