## 7. Statements

### i. **Hon. John Githinji Mwaniki (MCA, Geta Ward)**

Mr. Speaker Sir,

I beg to request for a statement from the Chairperson to the Committee on Industrialization, Trade, Cooperatives, and Tourism on the following issues concerning Geta Cooperative Society;

Aware that Cooperative societies are a key economic driver in the county with majority of county residents being members of cooperative societies and that the County government has a mandate to ensure regulation of cooperative societies.

Further aware that in Geta Ward there exists a cooperative society known as Geta Cooperative Society which has faced serious problems in its management.

Concerned that despite various attempts to have the County department responsible for Cooperatives has not addressed these issues adequately with the situation deteriorating with each passing day.

Mr. Speaker sir, premised on the foregoing, I now pray that the chairperson of the Committee for Industrialization, Cooperatives, Tourism and Wildlife does issue a statement to this house addressing the following issues;

- a. The veracity of allegations that Geta Cooperative Society has been ridden and rocked with poor management, lack of accountability and transparency by the Executive committee members particularly the chairman of the society;
- b. The rampant instances of unauthorized expenditure of the society's funds which are not well explained or accounted for;
- c. Why there has been a failure by the Executive Committee to convene Annual General Meetings in the past two years thereby denying the members a platform to air their views and vote on crucial matters affecting the society;
- d. Why there has not been audit of the society's accounts and the , lack of proper records and false documentation;
- e. Whether the Sub-county cooperatives officer has been compromised by the management of the society as he has severally acted only to safeguard the interest of the Chairman; and

- f. Whether procurement of works, goods and services has been in compliance with the procurement and disposal of goods Act now amended.

**ii. Hon. Monica Wamuyu (MCA)**

Mr. Speaker Sir,

I beg to request for a statement from the Chairperson to the Committee on Industrialization, Trade, Cooperatives, and Tourism on the following issues concerning Lake Ol'borosat;

Aware that Nyandarua County is bestowed with a natural feature in Lake Ol'borosat which has a big potential as a major tourism attraction in the county.

Further aware of the widespread encroachment of the lake which is a direct threat to the lakes ecosystem.

Concerned that urgent steps require to be taken to safeguard the existence and sustainability of the lake as a major tourism site in the county.

Mr. Speaker Sir, premised on the foregoing, I now pray that the chairperson of the Committee for Industrialization, Cooperatives, Tourism and Wildlife does issue a statement to this house addressing the following issues;

- a. Whether there are the existing boundaries of the Lake and the acreage thereof taken towards the final mapping and survey of the lake;
- b. Whether the lake has been gazette as a protected area;
- c. What progress has been made towards securing the lake from encroachment; and
- d. What steps have been undertaken to enhance and harness the tourism potential of the lake.
