APPENDIX

A: PROCEDURE FOR ADMINISTRATION OF OATH OR AFFIRMATION OF OFFICE IN ACCORDANCE WITH SECTION 9 OF THE COUNTY GOVERNMENTS ACT, 2012 AND ARTICLE 4 OF THE STANDING ORDERS

1. On the Order for Administration of Oath being read, the Assembly will remain seated.
2. The Clerk will call out the names of the Members in accordance with the order of Precedence Pursuant to Article 4(3) of the Standing Orders
3. The Member called by the Clerk will take up his/her position at the Bar.
4. He/she will then proceed to the podium where he/she will take the Oath.
5. The Member shall state to the Clerk whether s/he will use the Bible/Quran or Affirm.
6. Having taken the Oath/Affirmation of Office, the Clerk will shake hands with the Member who will then proceed to sign the Oath/Affirmation Book.
7. Having signed the Oath/Affirmation Book, the Member will proceed back to the Bar. Thereafter, the Member will proceed to his/her seat.
8. The Order in which Members will be called is as appears on the attached list.

B: PROCEDURE FOR ELECTION OF SPEAKER IN ACCORDANCE WITH ARTICLE 178 OF THE CONSTITUTION, SECTION 21 OF THE ELECTIONS ACT, 2011 AND ARTICLE 5,6,7,8,9,10, 11, 12, 13, 14 OF THE STANDING ORDERS

1. The Clerk will announce the names of the candidates validly nominated to contest for the Office of the Speaker.
2. The Clerk shall inform the Assembly that the names have been entered in the Ballot Paper
3. At the commencement of each ballot, the ballot box shall be displayed to the Assembly, empty and unlocked, after which it shall be locked and placed on the Table.
4. Each Member will receive one ballot paper for the purpose of electing a candidate.
5. When all Members present have voted, the Clerk shall unlock the box, examine and count the ballot papers and having rejected ballot papers not marked in accordance with the Standing Orders, announce the results of the ballot.
6. (1) A person shall not be elected as Speaker, unless supported in a ballot by the votes of two-thirds of all the Members.  
(2) If no candidate is supported by the votes of two-thirds of all the Members, a fresh election shall be held and in that election, the only candidates shall be:-
  - a) The candidate or candidates who received the highest number of votes in the ballot referred to in paragraph (1); and
  - b) The candidate or candidates who in that ballot received the next highest number of votes.  
(3) If more than one candidate receives the highest number of votes, paragraph (2) (b) shall not apply and the only candidates in the fresh election shall be those contemplated in paragraph 2(a).  
(4) The candidate who receives the highest number of votes in the fresh election shall be declared elected as Speaker.
7. If in the further ballot referred to in 6 above, more than one candidate receives the highest number of votes, the ballot shall again be taken, and if there is equality of

the highest number of votes, a further ballot shall be taken until one candidate obtains more votes than the other or others.

8. Immediately following the election of the Speaker, the Clerk shall administer the Oath or Affirmation of Office to the Speaker-elect in the presence of the assembled Assembly.
