Mr. Speaker, I beg to give notice of the following motion:

**Aware** that the Nyandarua County Government has in implementation of various projects in the past years incurred costs which are yet to be settled giving rise to bills pending payment;

**Further aware** that the settlement of the said pending bills has been subjected to various levels of audit for verification and ensure astute and prudent financial management; Noting that funds have been approved in the supplementary budgets for settlement of the pending bills;

**Further noting** that the amounts as appropriated do not adequately factor the full compensation of the pending bills approved by the audit committee for settlement;

**Considering that** the County Executive Committee Member for Finance and Economic Development has sought for the concurrence and approval of this house for the authority to utilize part of the amounts allocated for settlement of pending bills which have not been approved by the audit committee, but are factored in the Second Supplementary budget to settle the pending bills which have been approved by the Audit committee but have no allocation in the second supplementary budget;

**Now therefore** I urge that this House does approve and grant the concurrence for the utilization of the said funds to settle the approved pending bills in strict compliance with Section 135 of the Public Finance Management Act, 2012.

### Motions

#### i. **Hon. Edinald Wambugu King'ori (M.C.A. North Kinangop Ward)**

Mr. Speaker Sir, I beg to move the following motion:

**Aware that** the Constitution of Kenya 2010, under Article 11, recognizes culture as the foundation of the nation and as the cumulative civilization of the Kenyan people and nation;

**Further aware** that there is need to promote all forms of national and cultural expression through literature, the arts, traditional celebrations, science, communication, information, mass media, publications, libraries and other cultural heritage;

**Considering** that there is imminent need for the people of Nyandarua County to identify and secure their cultural identity and heritage through historical and cultural monuments as a way of safeguarding and realizing the ideals and principles which are their common heritage;

**Further considering** that the establishment, recognition and preservation of the historical and cultural monuments will not only pursue a policy of common action designed to safeguard and encourage the development of culture but also to preserve the relevance of our forefathers and other significant persons in the creation of history and pave way for future generations;

**Noting that** on construction the monuments as valuable and historical icons will be a matter of the County's protection and care;

**Now therefore,** this House does resolve that:

- a) There be established a Committee to carry out, among others:
  - i. identification of existing monuments in the County;
  - ii. identification and recommendation of suitable monuments to be erected in honour of the County's notable prominent personalities; and
  - iii. the sites for erection of such monuments.
- b) A budgetary allocation be set aside for the erection, care and protection of County monuments.
