#### Motions

(i) **Hon. Simon Sambigi Mukuriah (MCA, Githioro Ward)**

Mr. Speaker Sir, I beg to move the following motion;

**Aware** that Article 43 of the Constitution of Kenya provides a right for every person to clean and safe water in adequate quantities;

**Concerned** that a majority of Nyandarua County residents do not access clean and safe water through pipe reticulation to their homesteads;

**Appreciating** the potential of cooperative societies in participating in the business of supplying piped water to the residents of Nyandarua County;

**Noting** that the County Government has a role in promoting cooperative societies that address the social-economic needs of its people such as access to clean, safe and piped water;

**This Assembly therefore urges** the Nyandarua County Executive Committee to –

- i. initiate a programme in all county villages, sensitizing the Nyandarua County residents on the need to establish co-operative societies with a view of supplying piped water to the homesteads;
- ii. encourage the existing co-operative societies to venture in the business of supply of piped water to people within the jurisdictions of their operation; and
- iii. identify ways through which the county government can assist the said cooperative societies in ensuring the cost of water remains affordable to the people, such as subsidizing certain operational costs such as electricity.
