Mr. Speaker Sir, I beg to give notice of the following motion:-

Aware that the county government is tasked with enormous responsibility of county development which involves procurement of goods and services from various contractors and suppliers including supply from other government entities;

Further aware that some of the goods and services can readily be provided and sourced locally especially from among the youth and youth polytechnics.

Noting that there are twenty-four (24) public youth polytechnics in Nyandarua which provide various technical courses to the youths of Nyandarua and that they supply quality goods and services to other institutions in the course of their programs.

Appreciating that if the county government procures goods and services from these polytechnics, the move will uplift their financial standing and increase the quality of education offered.

Now therefore, this House does resolve:

1. **That** the County Executive Committee does formulate a policy outlining how departments shall procure certain categories and percentages of goods and services from the youth polytechnics; and
2. **That** the Executive Committee Member for Education, Culture, Gender Affairs and Social Services does initiate capacity building programs for the polytechnics to ensure that they have the requisite capacity to supply goods and services.
