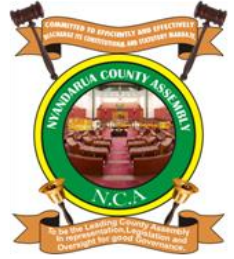

The House assembled at 2.30 p.m.

PRAYERS - Session began with a word of prayer by the Hon. Speaker as provided in the Standing Orders.

1. Administration of Oath

There was no oath administered all Members having taken oath of office.

2. Communication from the Chair

The Chair communicated that the Business in the supplementary order paper would first be dispensed with before going to the Order Paper of the day.

4. Petitions

5. Papers

- i. Hon. James Mwangi Gichuki the Leader of Majority did not table the Report of the Auditor General on the Financial Statements of the County Government of Nyandarua for the Sixteen (16) Months' Period Ended 30th June,

2014 as he was not present in the House. The Hon. Speaker directed that the business had been dropped and would only be introduced with the leave of the Speaker. Due to its importance the Chair directed that the Leader of Majority be informed to approach the Speaker for the same to be introduced in the House.

ii. Hon. Silvester Kagiri Mwangi the Chairperson, Committee on Public Accounts and Investment did not table the Report of the Public Accounts and Investment Committee on the Nyandarua County Budget Implementation for the Financial Year 2013/2014 as he was not present in the House.

The Hon. Speaker directed that the business had been dropped and would only be introduced with the leave of the Speaker. Due to its importance the Chair directed that the Honourable Member to informed to approach the Speaker for the same to be introduced in the House.
