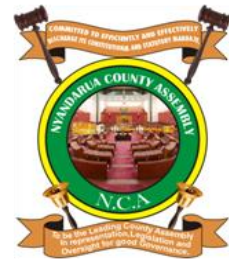

COMMUNICATION FROM THE CHAIR

Speaker: Hon. Members, I have a brief communication to make:

That on 28th May 2015, I received a letter from the Leader of Majority requesting that there be a special sitting today. The letter is worded thus:

The above subject refers.

Pursuant to Article 29 (1) and (2) of the Standing Orders, I hereby do request that the House does convene for a special sitting on Tuesday, 2nd June 2015. Mr. Speaker sir the Executive, on 20 May 2015, did forward to the office of the Clerk the Nyandarua County Executive Car Loan and Mortgage Fund Regulations 2015, amended as per the recommendations of the Committee on Delegated County Legislation and the resolutions of the House.

These regulations will operationalize the Nyandarua County Executive Committee Members' Car Loan and Mortgage Fund towards utilization of the money as allocated in the budget for the financial year 2014/2015.

In cognizance of the fact that we are almost at the close of the FY 2014/2015, it is prudent that the regulations be passed on deliberations by the House, time being of essence. For this reason I hereby request that a special sitting be convened to expend the same business. Your consideration is appreciated.

On the same day, that is, 28th May 2015, through a reply addressed to the Leader of Majority, the Hon. Members and the Clerk I acceded to the request for a sitting today, Tuesday 2nd June 2015, at 10 a.m. My letter bore the following content:
