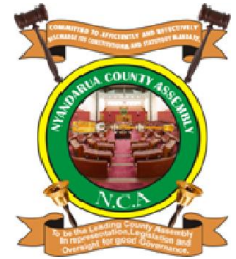

Concerned that as required by law, the Boards are required develop their respective human resource policies and adopt them.

Now therefore I urge that this Assembly does resolve that the County Public Service Board and the County Assembly Service Board do publish and publicize their policies with respect to public service and human resource management.
