- ii. **THAT** the House does convene on 27th June 2016 to consider the Budget Estimates and the report of the Budget and Appropriation Committee;
- iii. **THAT** the Budget and Appropriation Committee does use the budget estimates signed by the County Executive Committee Member for Finance as agreed upon; and
- iv. **THAT** the CEC member submits an itemized budget to the County Assembly.
