Noting that there is need for the National Council for Persons with Disability to devolve its functions and services in Counties particularly to Nyandarua County for effective accessibility of its services;

Further noting that there is established, in the county executive committee, a department dealing with matters of intergovernmental relations to coordinate cooperation between county governments and the national government and its entities;

I now therefore urge this Assembly does resolve that the county department on matters of intergovernmental relations does urgently take necessary steps, to ensure establishment of an office in Ol-Kalou Town, by the National Council for Persons with Disability.

Hon. James KiiruGachomba sought leave on behalf of Hon. Joyce Ng'ang'a who was absent and prayed that the House Business Committee does consider allocating time for the moving of the Motion at a later date.

The Hon. Speaker was aware of the absence of the Hon. Member and thus granted leave and directed the House Business Committee to allocate time for the moving of the Motion.
