



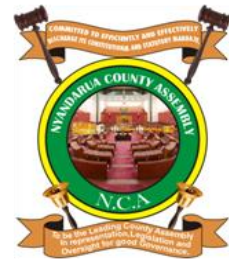

The Speaker made the following communications

COMMUNICATION FROM THE CHAIR

I wish to take this opportunity to extend a warm welcome to all of you for the second part of the third session of this August House. I hope, and trust, that the long recess has been excellent and fruitful particularly in according you the opportunity to meet the people you represent. As we begin this part of the third session, allow me to underscore the need to remain focused, as an Assembly, on our constitutional and legal mandate, that is, legislation, oversight and representation. This part of the session commences at a crucial time as we are expected to pass, before the 30th of June, 2015, the County Revenue Appropriations Bill which was tabled and read the first time before the House proceeded for recess. I hope that this House will meet the legal deadline and pass the aforementioned law.

I am aware that the Budget and Appropriations Committee is currently conducting public participation in the County in line with the requirement of the Constitution and other laws.

I am further aware that all Sectoral Committees have already scrutinized the budget estimates and submitted their reports with recommendations to the Budget and Appropriations Committee. This is commendable progress on the matter.

Hon. Members, I am aware that most Committees are seized with the draft bills which they intend to present to my office as legislative proposals for subsequent publication and tabling before this House. I am further aware that the Executive is also working on some bills which it intends to bring to the Assembly. Consequently and drawing inspiration from the above, I implore all of us to remain committed to the legislative agenda of the Assembly as it is one of its fundamental mandates.

Hon. Members, we must demonstrate vigilance in overseeing what the Executive is doing. This House is expected to pass the County Revenue Appropriations Bill FY 2015/2016 and as the same is being undertaken, we must remember that we passed a similar Bill for FY2014/2015 which is coming to an end very soon.

This is the time to ask difficult questions on implementation of the said Act, bearing in mind that the same sets the platform and the foundation for the economic development of the county. Otherwise, this House shall not have arisen to its mandate and functions.

This House, it must be remembered, has a place in shaping the county's development — a matter which we must take very seriously — by performing its legislative and oversight roles concurrently.

Hon. Members, allow me, at this juncture, to wish you an excellent second part of our third session.

Further, Hon members, I wish to communicate that, as you are aware, we are now approaching the deadline for submission of tax returns to the Kenya Revenue Authority which is the 30th day of June, 2015.

Further, you are aware that unlike before, the returns are now to be submitted individually and through an online process branded iTax.

In line with the same and in order to equip members with skills and knowledge about the process, the office of the Clerk shall conduct a demonstration of the same on Thursday, the 11th of June, 2015 immediately after the Assembly's sitting at Committee Room No. 1.

Accordingly, members are encouraged to attend the demonstration.
